The persons appointed to view the conveniencies and inconveniencies attending the turning Browne's road this day made their report in the following words to wit: In Obedience to an order of this worshipful court bearing date in July we the subscribers have viewed the road near John Cobb's as it is intended to be turned by Edwin Gray and John Cobb, and find that it will be attended by no disadvantage. Given under our hands this 17th Aug: 1779. Signed Charles Briggs. Ben^y. Ruffin jr. Whereupon on the motions of the said Edwin Gray and John Cobb they have leave to turn the said road mentioned in the said report.

The persons appointed to lett the building of a bridge over blackwater at the old courthouse this day made their report in the following words to wit: In Obedience to the within order we have agreed with Dempsey Marshall to build the bridge at blackwater for the sum of Six hundred, sixty five pounds fifteen shillings to be finished according to a plan agreed upon by the 20th day of November 1779 in personie and by consent of the persons appointed by the county court of Isle of Wight. Given under our hands this 17th day of July 1779. Rich^d. Wells. C. Cosby.

William Wister is by the court appointed overseer of the road from Jones' mill to the county line leading towards South of the room of John Cobb who is discharged from that office. It is further ordered that James & Matthew Garner's hands be added to his district.

James Wright is by the court appointed overseer of the road from Jones' to William Nelson's in the room of Job Johns who is discharged from that office.

William Branch is by the court appointed overseer of the road in the room of John Cobb who is discharged from that office.

John Mitchell is by the court appointed overseer of the road in the room of Ben^y. Ruffin who is discharged from that office.
