An indenture of ffeoffment between Jacob Wheeler and Sarah his wife of the one part and Jepc Glover of the other part was acknowledged by the said Jacob Wheeler and Sarah his wife she being first privily examined as the less dirccts and ordered to be recorded.

John Hancock returned his guardian accounts of Edwin & Mary Phillips orphans of Aaron Phillips deceased, Thomas Turner of Turner & Williamson ^{Esq} orphan of Edwin Williamson deceased, Miriam Scott & James Robert, Ann & Sarah Scott's estates, orphans of James Scott deceased, Henry of Ann Daffer's estate, orphan of Benj^o Daffer deceased, William Mackie of William Harris orphans estate, and Simon Stephenson of William Stephenson's estate, which severally being sworn to, examined and approved off by the court were ordered to be recorded.
