James Jones returned his guardian accounts of the estates of Margaret Casper and Mary Casper orphans of Nathan Casper deed. which being sworn to, examined and approved off by the court were ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Jacob Wheeler and Sarah his wife of the one part and Jesse Glover of the other part was acknowledged by the said Jacob Wheeler and Sarah his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

John Hancock returned his guardian accounts of David & Mary Phillips orphans of Aaron Phillips deed, Thomas Turner of Turner Williamsons ^{Executors} orphan of Edwin Williamson deed, Miriam Scott of James, Robert, Ann & Sarah Scott's estates, orphans of James Scott deed, Ann & Mary of Ann Casper's estate, orphan of Benj. Casper deed, William Machie of William Harris orphans estate, and Simon Stephenson of William Stephenson's estate, which severally being sworn to, examined and approved off by the court were ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Joseph Turner of the one part and Thomas Turner of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Richard Harrison and James McLeamy,
