The persons appointed to make partition and division of the lands and plantation in the bill mentioned this day made their report in the words following to wit:

Agreeable to an order of court we have set apart one third part  
of the lands and plantations whereon Israel Joyner died viztly  
for Sarah Joyners (relict said Joyner) part thereof and bounded  
as followeth viz beginning at a white oak in Nathan Barnes  
line near the old field, from thence to a persimmon tree in  
the old field, thence to a cherry tree near the dwelling house  
thence to a white oak in a branch near the old field, from  
thence to a pine in Edmund Day's line, thence along Day's line  
to Nathan Barnes' line, and from thence to the beginning  
containing by estimation Eighty acres. September 2. 1779.
