to with us. Witness our hands this 3^d day of October 1779. Nathl
Ch^r. Cosby. Whereupon it is ordered that the treasurer of this
county pay unto the said Dempsey Marshall the undertaking of this
county's part of Six hundred sixty five pounds and fifteen shillings
in proportion to the number of litchables, and account thereof with
the court.

An indenture of feoffment between John Waller of the one part
and Benjamin Waller of the other part and a memorandum of litch
of feisen thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of Ann Waller
one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oath
of two other witnesses is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Rice B. Pierce, John Pond, Jos. Lancaster and Chas
mund Cosby or any three of them view the bridge lately erected
over Broad water and report whether the same be completed
according to agreement.

Ordered that Joshua. Violson, Hardy Harris and Howell
Myrick or any two of them view the bridge lately built over
the three creeks called Moores bridge and report whether this
same be completed according to agreement.

Ordered that John Salter, Rice B. Pierce & John Pond or any
two of them examine state and settle an account current of
the estate of Richards Pond deed. and make report thereof
to this court.

The last will and testament of John Pope deed. was presented
in court by Ann Pope the Executrix and Matthew Underwood the
Executor therein named, proved by the oaths of Nathan Barnes and
Sarah Head the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And
on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law
a certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form giving security. Whereupon the said Ann Pope and Matthew
Underwood with John Underwood and John Powell their securities
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five
thousand pounds for the said Executors due and faithful administration
