

By virtue of the act of Assembly for laying a tax payable in
enumerated commodities Charles Briggs and Thomas Edmundson
appointed commissioners in this county for the purposes contained
in the said act.

The last will and testament of Thomas Burle, deceased, was presented

the oath of John Johnson one of the witnesses thereto and ordered
to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executor who,

acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand pounds
for the said Jespe's due and faithfull administration of the
decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Henry or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of
peace, for this county do appraise in current money the slave
and personal estate of Thomas Burle, deceased, and return the
appraisement to the next court.

Shadrack Lewis produced a commission from his Excellency
the Governor to be first Lieutenant of the militia of this
which was read, and thereupon the said Shadrack Lewis
first taken the oath of fidelity to this commonwealth was made
first Lieutenant accordingly.

Nathan Pope orphan of Nathan Pope, deceased, came into court
and chose Elijah Pope for his guardian. Whereupon the said
Elijah Pope with Ben. Blunt his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds
money for securing the said orphans estate and indemnity
this court.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till the court in October.
