Thomas Edmunds being appointed guardian
the defendants the cause was this day heard on the bill of the plain-
tiff and answer of the defendants, whereupon it is decreed and ordered
that John Taylor, Arthur Foster, Richard Blow and Alexander
Hurry or any three of them attell, apportion and set apart the dower of
the widow in the lands and flats whereof William Miller died,
revised and profided and make report thereof to this court.

George Washington is by the court appointed overseer of the rods in

On the motion of Jeppe Britain who made oath according to law and
feate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
estate of Eliska Britain decd. giving security. Whereupon the said
Jeppe Britain with Britain Joyner his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond for the penalty of Five thousand pounds
current money of Virginia for the said Jeppe's due and faithful ad-
ministration on the estates of the said decedent.

An account current of the estate of Richard Bond decd. was re-
cd pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Jeppe Williams and Isaac Wil-
iams administrators with the will annexed of James Moore, and
the one part and Thomas Peete of the other part was proved by
the oath of William Williams and by the solemn affirmation of
Jordan Denson one of the people called quakers / and continued for
further proof.

Ordered that James Moore of Surry county be summoned to appear
at the next Court to contest the noncupative will of Jeppe Moore
decd. if he sees fit.

Ordered that Samson Pitman, Moses Phillips, Charles Waller
and Charles Cosby or any three of them being first sworn before
justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money his
slaves if any and personal estate of Eliska Britain decd. and retain
the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that court be adjourned till the court in course.
