Thomas Edmunds being appointed guardian to
 the defendants the cause was this day heard on the bill of the plain-
 tiff and answer of the defendants, whereupon it is decreed and ordered
 that John Taylor, Arthur Foster, Richard Blom and Alexander
 Merry or any three of them allot, assign and set apart the dower of
 the widow in the lands and tenements whereof William Millar died
 seized and possessed and make report thereof to this court.

George Washington is by the court appointed overseer of the road in
 the room of Benjamin Parmer decd.

On the motion of Jesse Britain who made oath according to law and
 fee is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
 estate of Eliska Britain decd. giving security. Whereupon the said
 Jesse Britain with Britain Joyner his security entered into and
 acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five thousand pounds
 current money of Virginia for the said Jesse's due and faithful ad-
 ministration on the estate of the said decedent.

An account current of the estate of Richard Bond decd. was re-
 ceived pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffments between Jesse Williams and Isaac Wil-
 liams administrators with the will annexed of James Moore, decd. of
 the one part and Thomas Peete of the other part was proved by
 the oath of William Williams and by the solemn affirmations of
 Jordan Deason / one of the people called quakers / and continued for
 further proof.

Ordered that James Moore of Surry county be summoned to appear
 at the next court to contest the nuncupative will of Jer^s Moore
 decd. if he sees fit.

Ordered that Samson Pitman, Moses Phillips, Charles Collins
 and Charles Cosby or any three of them being first sworn before a
 justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the
 slaves if any and personal estate of Eliska Britain decd. and return
 the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that court be adjourn'd till the next in course
