

In a court held for the county of Southampton the 15th day of January 1780.

Present: Nicholas Maget, Micajah Holliman,
Elias Herring & Henry Brown, Gentlemen

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of William Grizzards
deed. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of John Brewer deceased was presented
in court by Ann Brewer the Executrix thereon named, proved by
the oaths of Geo. Little, Abram Porter and Rebecca Morgan the
witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the
said Executrix who made oath according to law certificate is granted
her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security.
Whereupon the said Ann Brewer with Elizabeth Morgan her security
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of Five
thousand pounds for the said Ann's due and faithful administration
on the said decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Gray, Richard Clifton, Colin Persons and John
McLemore or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of
the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any
and personal estate of John Brewer deceased and return the appraisement
to the next court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Benjamin Barnes
deed. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Joshua Bay deceased
was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Jacob Williams of the one part &
William Youkhart of the other part, a memorandum of livery of seisin
and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of Drury Andrews
one of the witnesses thereto and contained for further proof.

Edwin Gray Esq. produced a commission from his Excellency the Governor
to be sheriff of this county which was read. Whereupon the said Edwin
Gray with

his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond on the sum of
One thousand pounds payable and conditioned as in the said condition
directed, and having first taken the oath of office was sworn
sheriff of this county accordingly.

Edwin Gray Esq. sheriff of this county informed the court that
