Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the most capable freeholders of this county to appear at the next court to serve as a Grand Jury of inquest for the body of this county.

Joseph Gray Blunt came into court and chose Edwinn Gray for his guardian. Whereupon the said Edwinn Gray with Benjamin's staff for his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of Twenty thousand pounds for the securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

Ordered that John Wood and negroes London and Tony be added Betty Williams and negro Peter, Burnwell Beal, Nedsum Rogers, Nathan Turner, Thomas Turner and negro Jims and Ann Saller and negroes Lucy and Lettice be added to John Rogers list of slaves.
