+ Ordered that Prudence Jones and negroes Hector Glasgow and Sarah be added to James Ridley's list of tithables.

+ Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay unto Henry Taylor gentl. the sum of six hundred pounds in part for building Smiths bridge over the three creeks on his giving bond to the clerk or treasurer and security to finish the same by the first day of August next.

+ Ordered that the same persons take the list of tithables for the present year as the last except William Blunt in the same list formerly taken by him.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course.
