Lewis Thorpe being by the court appointed guardian to the defendant Lundy, and the said defendant having this day filed his answer to the plaintiffs bill of complaint, on the motions of this plaintiff time is allowed him untill the next court to reply thereto.

On the motion of Jos. Papper and for sufficient reasons appearing to this court he is exempted from payment of levies.

On the motion of Edwin Gray Gentlemen high sheriff of this county Benjamin Kirby and John Simons were sworn his undersheriffs.

On the motion of Anne Salter who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John Salter decd. giving security. Whereupon the said Anne Salter with John Cobb her security entered into and acknowledged this bond on the penalty of Fifty thousand pounds for the said Anne's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Samuel Drenory, William Spivey, Richard [unclear] and Rice B. Pierce or any three of them being first sworn as a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in value the Slaves if any and personal estate of John Salter decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

X Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay unto [unclear] the sum of Thirty pounds for services done the bridge at [unclear] ton county house and account with the court for the same.

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Eliska [unclear] decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.
