William Hines being by the court appointed guardian
to the defendant the cause was this day heard on the bill of the
plaintiff and answer of the defendant whereupon it is decreed and ordered,
that Cordall Horfleet, John Peter, John Wilkinson and Lazarus Cook or
any three of them assign, allott and set apart the dower of the plaintiff in
her lands and slaves whereof Mr. Crafford deceased seized and possessed off &
make report thereof to this court.

An indenture of feoffment between William Peterson of the one part
and Philip Peterson of the other part was acknowledged by the said William
Peterson and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Edmund Jenkins deceased was presented in
court by Valentine Jenkins the executor therein named, proved by the
wills of William Urquhart and Robert Eley two of the witnesses thereto &
named to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made
with according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate
therein in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Valentine
Jenkins with William Urquhart his security entered into and acknow-
ledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred thousand pounds for
the said Valentine's due and faithfull administration on the estate
of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Purcell, John Summerell, Benjⁿ. Crumpler &
William Jenkins or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves &
personal estate of Edmund Jenkins deceased and return the
same to the next court.
