The persons appointed to view the conveniencies and inconveniencies attending the turning a road near Charles Briggs plantation this day made their report in the following words. Southampton county Nov. 6. 1780

"In Obedience to an order of court bearing date July 1780 we Rich^d

"Kerr, James Jones & John Mitchell being first sworn to report the

"conveniencies and inconveniencies attending the turning a road,

"near Charles Briggs plantation and having performed the same

"do report that we think the road when well cleared will be as

"good as the old way and will be attended with no inconvenience

"to the public or any private person. Given under our hands this

"day &c. above written. Rich^d Kerr, James Jones, John Mitchell

Whereupon it is ordered that the said Charles Briggs have leave

to turn the said road according to the prayer of his petition.

An indenture of feoffment between Cooper Williams of the one part

and Nicholas Williams of the other part and the receipt thereon were

acknowledged by the said Cooper Williams and ordered to be

recorded.

The last will and testament of John Harris decd. was presented in
