An indenture of feoffment between Nathaniel Harris of the one part and Drury Harris of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of James Harris, Robert Ivey and Henry Thomas the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of David Edmunds dead was proved by the oaths of Samuel Nicolson and Hardy Grizzard two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

John Thomas Blow and William Urquhart are by the court appointed commissioners of the specific tax for the ensuing year.

An indenture of feoffment between Anthony Woolfolk of the one part and Benjamin Deloach of the other part was a memorandum of livery of seisin and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of Charles Robt one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses are ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that William Barnes and his male tithables be added to the road whereby George Washington is overseen.

The last will and testament of Arthur Dick dead was presented in court by Samuel Dick, one of the executors therein named, Liberty being reserved for the other) proved by the oaths of George Gadsby and Thomas Edwards two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Samuel Dick with Thomas Penson and J<sup>r</sup> Whitehead his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of One hundred thousand pounds for the said Samuel's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate & performance of his will.
