The indenture of feoffment between Nathaniel Harris of the one part and Drury Harris of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of James Harris, Robert Iny and Henry Thomas the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of David Edmunds dead. was proved by the oaths of Samuel Nielson and Hardy Grijard two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

John Thomas Blom and William Urquhart are by the court appointed commissioners of the specific tax for the ensuing year.

The indenture of feoffment between Anthony Woodthorp of the one part and Benjamin Deloach of the other part was a memorandum of livery of seisin and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of Charles Soss one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses are ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that William Barnes and his male tithables be added to the road of George Washington is overseen.

The last will and testament of Arthur Vick dead. was presented in court by Samuel Vick one of the executors therein named, (Liberty being reserved for the other) proved by the oaths of George Gudley and Thomas Edwards two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Samuel Vick with Thomas Ransom and Jesse Whitehead his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of One hundred thousand pounds for the said Samuel's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate & performance of his will.
