

The last will and testament of John Morgan deceased was proved by the oaths of William Foster and Lucy Kines two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

In the motion of Joshua Nickolson who made oath according to law certificate granted him for obtaining letters of administration with the will annexed in the estate of John Morgan deceased giving security. Whereupon the said Joshua Nickolson with George Whitehead his security entered into and acknowledged their bond on the penalty of Five hundred thousand pounds for the said Joshua's due and faithfully administration on the estate of the said deceased and performance of his will.

Ordered that Thomas Turner, Drury Harris, Sam. Westbrook Jr and John Person or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Morgan deceased and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Charles Bass deceased was presented in court by Arthur Matthews one of the executors therein named after others refusing the burden of the execution thereof proved by the oaths of Joshua Nickolson & Jeremiah Thorpe two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving bond and security at the next court.

Ordered that John Reese, John Joey, Joshua Harris and Moses Thorpe or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Charles Bass deceased and return the appraisement to the next court.

Nathan Barnes is by the court appointed committee to Ann Dick orphan of Joshua Dick deceased in the room of William Dick who is released it being alleged that the said infant is insane, the said Barnes giving bond and security at the next court.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till the court in course.
