

Richard's estate is by the court appointed guardians to Thomas, Samuel, John, James 139.
Whitson orphans of John Whitham dead. Whereupon the said Richard Kello
with John Wilkenson and Miriah Holliman his securities entered into and acknow-
ledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred thousand pounds for securing the
interests of the said orphans and indemnifying the court.

hundred thousand pounds for the said John Boykins due and faithful admi-
nistration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Lazarus Cook, Barton Taylor, Miriah Edwards & Charles
Lawson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for
this county do appraise in current money the slaves, if any, and personal
estate of John Pitman dead, and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Thomas Grenshaw dead, was proved by the
oath of William Gysaltay one of the witnesses thereto and having been before
proved by the oath of another witness is ordered, to be recorded.

Miriam Pitman came into court and chose John Boykin for her guar-
dian, Whereupon it is ordered, that the said John Boykin appear at the
next court to give bond and security for securing the said orphans estate
and indemnifying the court.

On the motion of Edwin Gray Gentl high sheriff of this county Joshua
Fort is sworn his undersheriff.

On the motion of Sarah Stephenson who made oath according to law certificate
is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of
Simon Stephenson dead. Giving security. Whereupon the said Sarah Stephenson
with Stephen Summerell her security entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand pounds for the said
Sarah's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate.

Ordered that John Summerell, James Summerell, Thomas Summer and
William Boykin or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves, if
any, and personal estate of Simon Stephenson dead, and return the apprais-
ment to the next court.

The last will and testament of Thomas Lankford dead, was presented in
court by Eliz. Lankford, Shadrach Lewis and Jesse Mountfortt the executors
and executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Joseph Mountfortt &
Thomas Mountfortt two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
And on the motion of the said executors and executors who made oath
according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof
in due form giving bond & security at the next court.
