to this court.

Lieutenant of the militia of this county.

On the motion of William Blunt, executor of the last will and testament of
John Sturgeon decd. who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for
obtaining a probat of the said will in due form giving security. Whereupon
the said William Blunt with Samuel Wells his security entered into and ac-
knowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred thousand pounds for the
said William's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent
and performance of his wills.

Ordered that John Blunt, Hardy Harris, Richard Harrison and Thomas Tar-
ner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this
county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of
John Sturgeon decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

William Blunt is by the court appointed a commissioner in the room of
Grove Guley clergyman who was judged incapable of serving being rector
of the parish of St. Luke.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till the court in course.
