



William Jones is by the court appointed to purchase a good waggon and a team of four good horses and complete harness pursuant to an act of the last assembly intituled An act for supplying the army with clothes, provisons and waggons.

Ordered that the sheriff of this county collect Fifty dollars from each titheable person in this county and that he therewith discharge the debts, salaries, fees and allowances as above extended, and that he pay to William Jones out of the sum remaining in his hands as much as will be needful to purchase a good waggon and team as agreeable to an act of the last session of the assembly and account with the court for the balance.
