Ordered that the sheriff of this county collect Fifty dollars from each tithable person in this county and that he therewith discharge the labours Salaries fees and allowances as above extended and that he pay to William Hines out of the sum remaining in his hands as much as will be needful to purchase a good waggon and team &c agreeable to an act of the last session of the assembly and account with the court for the balance.
