of John Francis one of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

The last will and testament of Benjamin Turner dead. was proved by the oaths  
of Elijah Crocker and Edith Finnebrow two of the witnesses thereto and ordered  
to be recorded. The executors having time allowed them to qualify thereto.

The last will and testament of John Morgan alias John Martins dead. was  
proved by the oaths of John Sammons and John Sledge two of the witnesses  
thereto and ordered to be recorded. The executor having time allowed him to  
qualify thereto

On the motion of Sarah Freeman who made oath according to law certificate  
is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John  
Freeman dead giving security at the next court.

Ordered that Thomas Turner, Drury Harris, Thomas Pock and James Loring  
or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for the  
county do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate  
of John Freeman dead and return the appraisement to the next court

An indenture of feoffment between Samuel Westbrooke of the one part  
and John Westbrooke of the other part was acknowledged by the said Samuel  
Westbrook and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of John Browne dead. was proved by the  
oaths of William Foster Jane Soloments and Lucy Hines the witnesses  
thereto and ordered to be recorded. The executrix refusing to qualify

An indenture of feoffment between William Barrett and Mary his  
wife of the one part and Jordan Brower of the other part was acknow-  
ledged by the said William Barrett and Mary his wife she being first  
lawfully examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Samuel Westbrook this day appeared and took the oaths prescribed by  
law as first lieutenant of a company of militia ~~command~~ of this county ~~command~~  
by captain John Barron.
