

On the motion of John Holt who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Charles Holt dead giving security. Whereupon the said John Holt with Holliday Aswill his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One hundred thousand pounds for the said Holt due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that John Simons, Benjamin Lewis, James Taylor and Alexander Murry or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Charles Holt dead and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Thomas Francis dead. was proved by the oath of Jepp Cooper one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oath of another witness is ordered to be recorded.

An account of the administration of the estate of Philip Glau dead. was reported pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Joshua Nielson dead. having been before proved by the oaths of the witnesses thereto was this day sworn to by Horrell Edmunds and John Kirby two of the executors therein named and certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Horrell Edmunds and John Kirby with Michael Warren their security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred thousand pounds for the said executors due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Timothy Thorpe, Owen Myrick, Amos Harris and William Moore or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Joshua Nielson dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

Elisabeth Francis widow and relict of Thomas Francis dead. appeared in court and declared that she would not accept of the legacies contained in her said husbands will and renounced all benefit thereby.

On the motion of Edmund Day who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Thomas Francis dead with the will of the said Thomas Francis giving security. Whereupon the said Edmund Day with William Francis and Stirling Francis his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred thousand pounds for the said Edmund due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.
