Ordered that Arthur Bowson, Laurence Joyner, Hardy Pope and John Pease for this county do appraise in current money the Slaves if any and the personal estate of Benjamin Griffin dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of feoffment between William Edmunds and Martha his wife of the one part and Samuel Ellis of the other part was acknowledged by the said William Edmunds and Martha his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Horwell Branch dead. was presented, in court by John Wellons one of the executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Benjamin Branch, Henry Branch and James Sumnerell the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Wellons with Thomas Lane his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand pounds for the said John's due and faithful administrations on the estates of the said decedents and performance of his will.

Ordered that Arthur Doles, Benjamin Warren, Robin Shields and James Sumnerell or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the Slaves if any and personal estate of Horwell Branch dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of Elizabeth Cobb who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Hardy Cobb dead. giving security. Whereupon the said Elizabeth Cobb with Holland Darden her security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand pounds for the said Elizabeth's due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.
