

An indenture of feoffment between Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife of the  
one part and Lewis Joyner of the other part was acknowledged by Isaac Williams  
and Priscilla his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and  
ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Joseph Johnston deceased was presented in court by  
Dorothy Beal one of the executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Madach  
Lewis and Joshua Beal two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.  
And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law, certificate  
is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Where-  
upon the said Dorothy Beal with William Edwards his security entered into  
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand pounds  
for the said Dorothy's due and faithfully administration on the estate of the said  
decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that James Wright, Matthew Wills, David Wright and Robert Reed or  
any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do  
appraise in current money the slaves, if any, and personal estate of Joseph Johnston  
dead and return the appraisement to the next court.

Jean Powers is by the court appointed guardian to Emanuel Powers orphan of  
Charles Powers deceased. Whereupon the said Jean Powers with Moses Johnson her  
security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred  
thousand pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

The last will and testament of Sarah Crocker deceased was presented in court by  
John Hendred the executor therein named, proved by the oath of Benjamin  
Hendred one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the mo-  
tion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him  
for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said  
John Hendred with Thomas Holladay his security entered into and acknow-  
ledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred thousand pounds for the  
said John's due and faithfully administration on the estate of the said decedent  
and performance of her will.

An indenture of feoffment between William Denson, Elisabeth Denson,  
widow and relict of Francis Denson deceased, and Ann Denson daughter and  
devisee of the said Francis of the one part and David Denson of the other  
part was proved by the oaths of Jethro Joyner and Charles Councill two of  
the witnesses thereto who also deposed that they saw Benjamin Griffin  
the third witness thereto who is since dead subscribe his name as such  
and is ordered to be recorded.
