Ordered that John Wilkinson Lazarus Cook, John Paiter and John Blunt or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Crafford dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that John Powell, Benjamin Blunt, Edmund Day and Nathan Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Porter dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Joshua Fort dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Pursuant to the decretal order of this court for the defendant to make sale of the lands and slaves in the bill mentioned at publick auction at twelve months credit for inspected Virginia crop tobacco the said defendant this day return'd his report in the following words to wit: "Southampton county f. Pursuant to a decree of the court of the county aforesaid dated September 1780. "have sold the lands and slaves belonging to the estate of Thomas Turner dead. to wit the tract of land on Parrarrows creek containing 835 acres more or less sold to Col^l Benjamin Blunt for 75000 lbs of tobacco, the tract on the Angellia swamp containing two hundred acres to Captⁿ John Barrow for 26500 lbs of tobacco. Negroes Jacob, Aimey and Fryal. sold to Matthews Turner for 38500 lbs of tobacco. Negroes Andrew and Lettice to William Pope for 22500 lbs of tobacco. Negroes James and Hannah to Charles Ross for 4050 lbs of tobacco for
