An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Nathaniel Coker decd.

was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of William Edwards decd. was presented in
 court by George Gurley the executor therein named proved by the oaths of
 George Edwards and George Gurley two of the witnesses thereto and ordered
 to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according

to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form
 giving security Whereupon the said George Gurley with John Simmons his
 security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred
 pounds specie for the said Gurley's due and faithful administration on the
 estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Lorchshaw, Jeremiah Drake, Drury Beal and Sam-
 uel Story or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the
 peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and per-
 sonal estate of William Edwards decd. and return the appraisement to the
 next court.

Ordered that Richard Kella and Moses Philips let the repairs of the light-
 wood bridge to the lowest undertaker for tobacco and make report thereof to
 this court.

Benjamin Branch is by the court appointed surveyor of the high way
 from Lauck to round hill swamp and it is ordered that the said Ben-
 jamin Branch with the male titheables belonging to the said road keep the
 same in repair according to law.

Ordered that Mark Nicholson, Arthur Foster and John Fort or any two of
 them let the rebuilding of Buckhorn bridge for tobacco to the lowest under-
 taker and make report thereof to this court.

Ordered that Richard Kella, Moses Philips and Sampson Roman or
 any two of them examine, stale and settle an account current of the
 estate of Patience Cown decd. and make report thereof to this court.

Ordered that John Thomas Blow, William Edwards and John Simmons
 or any two of them let the building of a bridge over Rolloway river near
 this courthouse for tobacco to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof
 to this court.

Ordered that John Blunt, Nathan Harris and John Tindred or any two
 of them let the repairs of flat swamp bridge near Nathan Harris for tobacco
