An indenture of feoffment between Jordan Denson of the one part and William Gray of the other part was acknowledged by the said Jordan Denson and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Eustace Windham of the one part and John Windham jun^r of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Beverley Booth and Moses Booth two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

The last will and testament of William Barker dead. was presented in court by Richard Marks and Joseph Marks two of the executors therein named, the widow being dead, proved by the oaths of Richard Marks, Lucy Barker and Nancy Barker the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Richard Marks and Joseph Marks with John Fort their security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds specie for the said executors due and faithfull administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Howell Harris, James Barkham, James Battle and Thomas Williams jun^r or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of William Barker dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that Benjamin Butts, Henry Hoop and negroes Sam, Hannah, Venus and Maggie be added to William Skunt's list of tithables.
