X William Edwards and John Barron appeared and took the oaths of vestrymen of the parish of Saint Luke.

X Thomas and Miles Kirby orphans of Richard Kirby dead. came into court and chose Benjamin Kirby their guardians. Whereupon the said Benjamin Kirby with Richard Kirby his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the estates of the said orphans and indemnifying the court.

John Williams Surgeon orphan of John Surgeon dead. came into court, chose Thomas Williams his guardians. Whereupon the said Thomas Williams with William Hines and John Powell his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

On the motion of John Barron executor of the last will and testament of Edwin Tunnebroes dead, who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Barron with David Barron his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said John's due and faithfull administration on the estate of the said deceased and performance of his will.

Ordered that Michael Warren, John Kirby, Robert Biddle and James Dren or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate of Edwin Tunnebroes dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

X An inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Porter dead was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of James Lundy dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Joseph Turner orphan of Thomas Turner dead. came into court and chose John Barron his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.
