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The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Hardy Cobb dead. was returned & ordered to be recorded.
The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Benjamin Clements dead. in Whit Lake Parish was returned and ordered to be recorded.
The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Charles Woodard dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Pursuant to an act of assembly intituled "An act for ascertaining certain taxes and duties and for establishing a permanent revenue" the court do appoint Benjamin Ruffin, John Simmons son^r and Arthur Foster to be commissioners for ascertaining the value of all lands within the county of Southampton, except the lands belonging to the said commissioners which Benjamin Blunt and Henry Browne gentlemen are appointed to value, as directed by the said act.

Pursuant to an act of assembly, intituled "An act for laying taxes on certain enumerated commodities" the court do appoint Charles Briggs and John Thomas Blom to be commissioners to receive the enumerated commodities mentioned in the said act.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Garner dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of William Cleveland dead. was proved by the oath of Lydia Jackson one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oath of another witness is ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Richard Jones dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Thomas Francis dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Charles Hatfield dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory of the estate of William Turner dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Mary Harris dead. was presented in court by Drury Harris one of the executors therein named, proved by the oath of Priscilla Hammark one of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof. And on the petition of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Drury Harris with Hardy Applewhite his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for the said decedent's due and faithfull administration on the estate of the said decedent in performance of her will.
