Saint Luke parish. - The first district to be formed by Captain Simmons, Captain Joyner's and Captain Tello's companies of militia, Benjamin Ruffin jun. gentleman to take the list of the enumerated articles therein. The second district to be composed by the militia companies commanded by Captain Holliman, & Captain Boykin, Muzak Holliman gentleman to take the list as aforesaid, and the third district to be composed by Captain Herring's, Captain Lewis, and Captain Mitchell's companies of militia, the list of the enumerated articles to be taken by Henry Browne gentleman.
