companies commanded by Captain Holliman, & Captain Boykin, Micah
Holliman gentleman to take the list as aforesaid, and the third district
to be composed by Captain Horring, Captain Lewis, and Captain Pitt-
rell's companies of militia, the list of the enumerated articles to be taken
by Henry Browne gentleman
