Elizabeth Briggs Francis is by the court appointed guardian to Charlotte Polly
and Jean Briggs Francis orphans of Thomas Francis dead. and Willie Francis
another orphan of the said Thomas came into court and chose the said
Elizabeth Briggs Francis for his guardian. Whereupon the said Elizabeth Briggs
Francis with William and Sterling Francis her securities entered into and ac-
knowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand pounds for securing the
estate of the said orphans and indemnifying the court.

Pamela Collier Francis orphan of Thomas Francis dead. came into court and
chose William Francis his guardian. Whereupon the said Pamela Collier
Francis with John Mundell junior his security entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for securing the said orphans
estate and indemnifying the court.

The last will and testament of Elizabeth Edwards dead was presented in court
by William Edwards and Benjamin Blunt the executors therein named,
swore by the oaths of John T. Blow and Benjamin Spivey the witnesses
thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executors
who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining
a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Benjamin
Blunt and William Edwards with John Thomas Blow and William
Thomas their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said executors due and faithfull
administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his
will.

Ordered that Thomas Edmunds, William Francis, Thomas Vaughan and John
Underwood or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of
this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of
Elizabeth Edwards decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of William Andrews who made oath according to law certificate is
granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William Morgan
dead / the widow refusing giving security. Whereupon the said William Andrews
with Jeremiah Dror his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
penalty of One thousand pounds for the said Andrews' due and faithfull adminis-
tration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Richard Clifton, Benjamin Harrison, Sepons Blake and
Thomas Turner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the
peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal
estate of William Morgan dead and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of Alice Simmons who made oath according to law certificate
is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Samu-
