Whereupon the said Benjamin Blunt and William Edwards with John Thomas Blows and William Thomas their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said executors due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Thomas Edmunds, William Francis, Thomas Laughan and John Underwood or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Elizabeth Edwards deed. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of William Andrews who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William Morgan deed. the widow refusing giving security. Whereupon the said William Andrews with Jemimah Drow his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for the said Andrews due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Richard Clifton, Benjamin Harrison, Sissors Blake and Thomas Turner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of William Morgan deed. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of Miss Simmons who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Samuel
