or any three of them view the conveniences and inconveniences attending the  
turning of a road near Josiah Peck and make report thereof to this court.

Benjamin Waller is by the court appointed a constable of this county whereupon  
the said Waller having taken the oaths prescribed by law was sworn constable  
standingly.

Benjamin Blunt gentleman is by the court appointed guardian to William  
and Simon Turner orphans of Thomas Turner deed. Whereupon the said Benjamin  
Blunt with Jesse Whitehead his security entered into and acknowledged their bond  
in the penalty of One thousand pounds for securing the said orphans estate and  
satisfying the court.

Ordered that the sheriff summon 24 of the most capable persons of this county not  
being ordinary keepers, constables, surveyors of highways, or owners or occupiers of a mill  
to appear at the courthouses on the second Thursday in May next and be sworn a  
grand jury of inquest on the body of this county
