

On the motion of William Cribbons he is allowed to keep an ordinary at the usual place near the court house for one year from this time giving security. Whereupon the said William Cribbons with his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Fifty pounds for his keeping the said ordinary according to law and it is ordered that the clerk of this court prepare a license for him according to law.

The last will and testament of Philip Person deceased was presented in court by Temperance Person the executors thereto named, proved by the oaths of Thomas Turner and John Westbrook two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Temperance Person with Timothy Phelps her security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said Temperance due and faithfull administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that William Andrews, Richard Clifton, Richard Harrison and Benjamin Harrison or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Philip Person deceased and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Colin Person deceased was presented in court by Elizabeth Person the executors thereto named, proved by the oath of Thomas Turner one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Elizabeth Person with William Andrews her security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand pounds for the said Elizabeths due and faithfull administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Charles Ross, Henry Harrison, Simon Harris and William Little or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Colin Person deceased and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of feoffment between Charles Barrett of the one part and William Urquhart of the other part and the receipt whereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Thomas Fearn and William Boykin two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.
