Indenture of feoffment between Jacob Barnes of the one part and William Barnes of the other part a memorandum of livery of seisin and the receipt thereon endors'd were acknowledged by the said Jacob Barnes and sworn to be recorded.

Indenture of feoffment between Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife the one part and Arthur Joyner of the other part and the receipt thereon endors'd were acknowledged by the said Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Upon the petition of Gadoc Bell for leave to erect a water grist mill on the west branch of the racoon swamp and setting forth that he hath lands on the said swamp and praying for an acre on the opposite side for the purpose aforesaid it is Ordered that the sheriff summon a jury of twelve freeholders of the vicinage to meet upon the said land and being first sworn before a magistrate or the said sheriff do diligently view and examine the lands petition'd for and all other lands on both sides of the run of the said swamp that may be affected or laid under water by building the said mill together with the timber and other conveniences thereon, that they report the true value of the acre petition'd for and the damages to every person or persons holding lands on the said swamp to the next court under their hands &
