port that the acre of land petitioned for is of the value of ten shillings
and that the building the said mill will not be to the damage or prejudice
of any other person or persons whatsoever. Given under our hands & seals
this 24th day of January 1782. John Simmons, Dk. Rice B. Pierce, John
Adams, Jesse Brington, Ben^r. Stewart, Jacob ^{his} Joyner, John Hooby,
James Vick, Lewis Joyner jun^r. Lewis Joyner sen^r. Joshua Wood, Thomas
Joyner, Richard Pond." Whereupon it is ordered that the said William
Gray be permitted to erect the said mill according to law.

Ordered that Micajah Holliman, Williams Urquhart and John
Clayton or any two of them do in conjunction with persons appointed
by the worshipful court of Sessions of Wight county view the lands stated
in the agreement relative to the building of broad water bridges and make
reports thereof to this court.
