Whereupon it is ordered that the said William Gray be permitted to erect the said mill according to law.

Ordered that Micajah Holliman, Williams Arquhart and John Clayton or any two of them do in conjunction with persons appointed by the worshipfull court of Isle of Wight county view the true state of the agreements relative to the building of broad water bridge and make report thereon to this court.
