Ordered that George Whitehead take the list of tithables in the districts composed by Captain Blow's and his own company of militia, Benjamin Blunt in the district composed by Captain Hargrave's and Captain Taylors company of militia, William Blunt in the district composed by Captain John Blunts and Captain Barrow's companies of militia, Timothy Thorpe in Horwell Myricks company of militia, Benjamin Suffin in Captain Simmonds' and Captain Tello's companies of militia, John Simmonds in Captain Joyner's and Captain Mitchell's companies of militia, Henry Browne in Captain Lewis' and Captain Kerigot's companies of militia, and Micah Holliman in the district composed by Captain Boykins and his own companies of militia.
