

On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney a commission is awarded him to examine and take the depositions of William Andrews and John Powell giving legal notice of the time and place of executing the same.

Robins a negro man slave, belonging to Arthur Dick is for sufficient reasons of

X bearing to this court exempted from payment of taxes.
Ordered that John Taylor, Thomas Ridley, and Mark Nicholson or any two of them examine, state and settle an account current of the estate of Williams

X Turner dead, and make report thereof to this court.
Rose belonging to the estate of John Garner dead, is for sufficient reasons appearing to the court exempted from payment of taxes.

Ordered that John Simmons, John Thomas Blom and William Edwards or any two of them view the bridge lately erected over Nollorway near this place, & report whether the same is completed according to agreement.

Ordered that the hands who formerly resided on the road from the three y-pole bridge to the flag run be added to the road leading from the courthouse to Nollorway swamp and that the overseer of the same keep the said road in repair according to law.

Ordered that John Thomas Blom be appointed overseer of the road from the courthouse bridge to Barron's road, and that the hands belonging to this road from by-pole bridge to Dick's swamp be added to the said road, and that he keep the same in repair according to law.

On the motion of Moses Johnson who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Henry Williams dead, giving security. Whereupon the said Moses Johnson with others Bonins his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred and fifty pounds with conditions as the law directs for the said Moses due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Arthur Boykin Stephen Sumnerell, John Sumnerell & Thomas Sumnerell or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves, if any, and personal estate of Henry Williams dead, and return the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that John Thomas Blom with the hands belonging to his road, William Pope and the hands belonging to his road, the overseer of the road from Duckton bridge to the great ^{road} with the hands belonging to the said road, and Williams Williams with the hands under him meet at the courthouse bridge and cut a cause way to the southside of the said bridge.

Ordered that George Washington with the hands on his road, Thomas Dick with the hands on his road, Robert Dick with the hands on his road, and John Smith with the hands on his road meet at the courthouse and cut a causeway to the northside of the bridge lately built near this place.
