Upon the petition of Richard Edwards for leave to erect a water grist mill across Tarapin swamp and setting forth that he has lands on one side of the said swamp opposite to the lands in possession of William Williford and praying for an acre of the said Williford's land it is ordered that the sheriff summon a jury of twelve freeholders of the vicinage to meet upon the said land and being first sworn before a magistrate or the said sheriff do diligently view and examine the lands petitioned for and all other lands on both sides of the run of the said swamp that may be affected or laid under water by building the said mill, together with the timber or other conveniences thereon, that they report the true value of the acre petitioned for, and the damages to every person or persons holding lands on the said swamp to the next court under their hands and seals.
