The persons appointed to view the bridge lately erected over Rottoway near this place this day reported that the same is completed according to agreement whereupon it is ordered that the treasurer of this county pay unto Joseph Whitehead the undertaker thirteen thousand eight hundred and ninety pounds of tobacco for the same and account thereof with the court.

Next a negro man slave belonging to James Jones, Harry and Fortunes belonging to Jeremiah Drown, Peter belonging to Hardy Harris, Venus to Abram belonging to Benjamin Batts, and Simon and Jack belonging to Moses Foster are for sufficient reasons appearing to this court exempted from payment of taxes.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of Rottoway bind out John Prosper orphan of William Prosper dead, according to law.

Sarah a negro woman slave belonging to Benjamin Terry, Grace belonging to Benjamin Stewart and Rose belonging to Elizabeth Pick are for sufficient reasons appearing to this court exempted from payment of taxes.
