randum of living of said therein endorsed were acknowledged by the said John
Sumnerell and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Henry Williams dead. was re-
turned and ordered to be recorded.

The persons appointed by the last will and testament of James Lundy dead. to
make an equal division and partition between Darling Adams, Edwin Adams
and Colin Adams sons of Mary Adams of the following slaves to wit: Pat, Dick,
Milley, Herbert, Nat, John, George, Lewis & James this day reported as follows to
wit: Pursuant to the last will of James Lundy dead. as the subscribers have allotted
and set apart to Darling, Edwin & Colin Adams the following negroes to wit:
To Darling Adams Neg. Pat, Herbert & James, the said Darling Adams is to
pay three hundred and thirty three pounds six shillings and eight pence. To Ed-
win Adams Negs Dick, Nat and Lewis, the said Edwin Adams to receive
one hundred sixty six pounds thirteen and four pence. To Colin Adams Neg:
George, Milley and John the said Colin Adams to receive one hundred sixty
six pounds thirteen and four pence. Given under our hands this 5th day of
April 1781. Signed William Blunt, Lewis Thorpe, John Myrick.

On the motion of Samuel Scarborough, Benjamin Bradley who has formerly
bonds to him is released from his indenture, and it is ordered that the church-
wardens of the parish of Hottoway bind the said Bradley to Stephen Sumnerell
according to law.

The last will and testament of Jesse Drons dead. was proved by the oath of Ri-
chard Blom one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the
oath of Timothy Thorpe another witness thereto is ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Priscilla Blunt dead. was presented in
court by John Blunt the executor therein named proved by the oaths of
of Nathan Bryant and Calias Bryant two of the witnesses thereto and
ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made
oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof
in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Blunt with Ed-
win Blunt his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty
of Five thousand pounds with condition as the law directs for the said
John's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent
and performance of his will
