Wherefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant and Samuel Blifton the said Eleven pounds six shillings and eight pence, and his costs by him about his suit on that behalf expended, and the said defendant in money &c.

But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Thre. pounds one shilling and one pence half pence together with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from March 10th 1780 till payment.
