 by the said Thomas Dillons and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke bind out Jeph Turner
 orphan of Thomas Turner and Israel Arles ~~and~~ a bastard child according to
 law.

Elizabeth Cley produced an instrument of writing under her hand and seal
 emanating the following slaves to wit: Rose, David, Venus & Jeddith which
 was proved by the affirmations of Thomas Ricks & Jordan Denson. two of the
 witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Samuel Bailey a witness for Joseph Holliman Esq. de of
 Robert Mercer dead, against Henry Branch it is ordered that the said Joseph
 Holliman pay ^{him} one hundred pounds of tobacco for attending this court one day
 and travelling 25 miles once & returning according to law.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course.

 proved by the affirmation of Thomas Dillons and Joseph Bailey two of the
 witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An instrument of writing under the hand and seal of Sam Ricks emanat-
 ing a negro woman slave named Jean was proved by the affirmations of Robert
 Ricks and Thomas Ricks the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
