Dyell and Matthew Jones three of the witnesses thereto, acknowledged by Sarah  
Johnson she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded  
An indenture of bargain and sale between Nathaniel Felts of the one part  
and Samson Pitman of the other part was acknowledged by the said Nathe-  
nial Felts and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Benjamin Barham of the one  
part and Alexander Murray of the other part was acknowledged by the said  
Benjamin Barham and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Arthur Foster, John Taylor and Mark Nicolson or any two of  
them examine state and settle an account current of the estate of William Miller  
dead. and make report thereof to this court

Samuel Jones produced an instrument of writing under his hand and seal emancipat-  
ing two slaves to wit: Ned and Patt which was acknowledged by the said Samuel  
Jones and ordered to be recorded.

Jeremiah Drafer produced an instrument of writing under his hand and seal.  
for the emancipation of his negro Jenny which was acknowledged by the said Jeremiah  
Drafer and ordered to be recorded.

An instrument of writing under the hand and seal of Mary Hargrave eman-  
cipating the ten following slaves to wit: Cupid, Buford, Sally, Abraham, Glee,  
Ned James, Peter, Silver & Sampson was proved by the said solemn affirmation  
of Samuel Jones and Jeremiah Drafer two of the witnesses thereto and ordered  
to be recorded
