In Chancery

Thomas Edmunds being by the court appointed guardian to the defendants this cause was this day heard on the bill of the complainant and answer of the defendants. On consideration whereof it is deemed and ordered that John Wilkinson, John Powell, and Nathan Harris or any two of them shall assign and set apart the share of the Plaintiff in the lands and slaves whereof Edmund Day died seized and possessed and make report thereof to this court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that the sheriff summon 24 of the freeholders of this county, not being ordinary justices, constables, surveyors of highways, or owners or occupiers of a mill to appear at the courthouse of this county on the second Thursday in May next, and be sworn a grand jury of inquest on the body of this county.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke bind out William Sandifer a bastard child according to law.

William Whitehead is by the court appointed guardian to Abner Day orphan of Edmund Day dead. Whereupon the said William Whitehead with Thomas Edmunds his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Fifteen hundred pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Jesse Casper of the one part and John Rochelle of the other part was acknowledged by the said Jesse Casper and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Thomas Drake dead. was presented in court by Abraham Joyner one of the executors therein named the widow Sarah refusing to prove by the oaths of Lewis Joyner jr. & Lewis Joyner sen: two of the next of kin thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Abraham Joyner with Lewis Joyner jr. his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Three thousand pounds for the said Abraham's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Lewis Joyner jun: John Beaton, John Davis and Isaac Williams or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace of this county to appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Thomas Drake dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the complaint of Isaac Williams against William Vaughan, Nevitt Edwards, Benjamin Edwards, George Farley jun: and Carter Henderson for a breach of the peace it is ordered that the said William Vaughan and Nevitt Edwards give security for their good behaviour for 12 months the principals for £200 each and their securities for £250 each, Benjamin Edwards, George Farley jr. & Carter
