 any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise
 in current money the slaves and personal estate of Philip Moody dead. and return the
 appraisement to the next court

The last will and testament of John Foster dead. was presented in court by Haley Foster
 one of the executors therein named proved by the oaths of John Mundell and James
 Clark two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of
 the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for ob-
 taining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Haley
 Foster with Arthur Foster his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
 penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said Bailey's due and faithful administration
 in the state of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that John Rogers, Samuel Blake, Howell Edwards and William Edwards
 or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do
 appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of John Foster dead.
 and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between William Hay, surviving partner of
 Philip John Hay and company of the one part and Thomas Fitzhugh of the other
 part was proved by the oaths of John Rogers and John Taylor two of the witnesses
 thereto and ordered continued for further proof

The last will and testament of Anne Branshars dead. was proved by the oath of
 Nicholas Maget one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oath
 of another witness is ordered to be recorded

James Johnson and Isham Bunn being brought before the court for a breach of the
 peace it is ordered that they find security for their good behaviour for 12 months
 Whereupon the said James Johnson with Josiah Worrell his security and Isham
 Bunn with Nathan Summrell his security acknowledged themselves indebted to
 this our commonwealth, that is to say, the said Johnson & Summrell in the sum of
 one hundred pounds each and their securities in the sum of Fifty pounds each to
 be levied of their respective lands and tenements goods & chattels and to this our
 commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said James Johnson
 and Isham Bunn shall be of good behaviour during the said space of 12 months
 and pay the costs of this prosecution then the above recognizance to be void

John Andrews is by the court appointed guardian to Samuel Moody & West
 Moody orphans of Philip Moody dead and Elizabeth Moody another orphan of the
 said Philip Moody dead. came into court and chose the said John Andrews for
 her guardian. Whereupon the said John Andrews with James Butler his security enter-
 ed into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Three thousand pounds for
 securing the estates of the said orphans and indemnifying the court
