

This day came as well the plaintiffs by their attorney as the defendants in their proper persons who confessed the plaintiffs action for Thirty nine pounds twelve shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore on the motion of the said plaintiffs by their attorney it is considered by the court that the plaintiffs recover against the said defendants the said Thirty nine pounds twelve shillings and their costs by them about their suit in that behalf expended, and the said defendants in mercy do.

But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Sixteen pounds sixteen shillings ^{2s.} together with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of 5% Centum per annum from January 9th 1783 till paid. Upon the petition of Etheldred Taylor and Daniel Fisher executors of the last will and testament of Henry Taylor decd. against Thomas Bradshaw for one pound nineteen shillings and interest due by note. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney, and the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing on the motions of the plaintiffs it is considered by the court that they recover against the said defendant the said one pound nineteen shillings together with interest thereon from October 1st 1770 till paid and their costs by them in that behalf expended.
